

Course Description Berlitz Arabic L1 to L4:

All basic dialogs and drills are in transliteration in latin as well as in Arabic letters to accommodate those who already know the Arabic letters.

Each level consist of:

- * Student Reader
- * Audio CD and
- * Teacher's Manual
- * End of level tests

The four levels are a new version of the Levantine Berlitz Arabic L1-4 SR that all Arabic teachers enjoyed teaching and still find very useful.

Our focus is on conversation making sure students are drilled and end-up using the spoken language they studied in class.

We teach all language skills: Our **Modern Standard Arabic and CDs** helps students' reading and writing skills. We have incorporated the chapters into our new **Berlitz Arabic SR**.

Level 1: Knowledge of Arabic is sufficient to communicate in a very limited way, with the simplest oral and listening tasks and situations.

Level 2: At this level, the users have a basic command of the language needed in a limited range of simple, routine, and familiar tasks and situations.

Level 3: Users can handle most uncomplicated communicative tasks and routine social and work situations. They can follow the general meaning of a conversation about familiar subjects.

Level 4: At this level, users are able to refashion and combine learned material to meet their immediate communication and learning needs. They are able to comprehend information on familiar topics in contextualized settings and produce sustained conversation with others on an expanding variety of general topics.

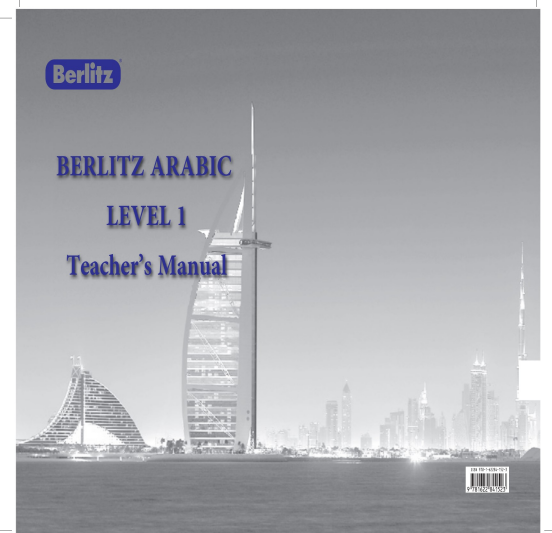
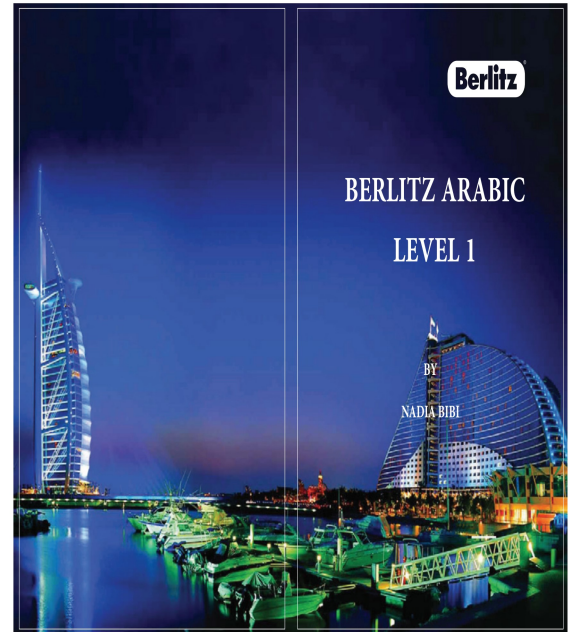

Course Description:

This program is a supplement to the Berlitz Arabic Colloquial material. As students are taught conversation for levels 1 – 4, this book introduces them to the alphabet and the written form of the language.

Users will be introduced to the Arabic alphabet. They will become familiar with the classical pronunciation. They will learn reading and writing words and sentences using the Arabic letters.

They will be able to differentiate between alphabets that are similar in writing and those that are similar in pronunciation.

They also learn the special Arabic additions to the alphabets (hamza, madda, tanween...etc.)
